NUMBER:

Counting from 1 to 50 Counting in two's up to 20 (at least)

NUMBER RECOGNITION;

Identifying numerals and associating them with their names and number Number names 0 - 20Sequencing numbers (demonstrate and understanding of serial order of the number 1 - 10)

Read a write Ordinal Numbers from 1st to 20th

Fractional Numbers - words and figures (show one half and fourth of a given set)

ADDITION (one digit numerals)
